OUR CAMPAIGN

CND campaigns for a world without nuclear weapons.

We want to see the UK scrap its nuclear weapons system, Trident, and cancel plans for its replacement. We also want the other eight nuclear-armed states to give up their nuclear arsenals.

This is a position shared by the global majority. Last year the UN Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons came into force but the UK outright rejects the Treaty. The British government is refusing to participate as an observer at the first meeting of states parties to the treaty (known as 1MSP).

In response, CND is launching a campaign to get Britain to attend the conference so it can start taking real steps to support a nuclear weapons-free world.

MORE ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

What?

The TPNW entered into force in 2021 making nuclear weapons illegal in the countries that sign it. The states that have ratified the treaty are gathering to discuss the next steps for implementing the agreement.

When and where?

Participants will gather at the United Nations building in Vienna between March 22nd-24th, 2022.

Who?

States that have ratified the treaty 90 days prior to 1MSP will be able to participate as states parties, and are thereby entitled to voting and other rights.

Other states can attend as observers. Civil society will also be in attendance.

ACTION 1

Contact the Foreign Secretary

The Foreign Secretary is responsible for making decisions on international treaties and should be the UK government's representative at the conference.
