BIOGRAPHIES



Bell Ribeiro-Addy was elected to parliament as MP for Streatham in 2019. She devoted her maiden speech to reparations to former colonial subjects, and served briefly as Shadow Minister for Immigration under Jeremy Corbyn. Bell is a member of the Socialist Campaign Group of MPs and a Vice Chair of Parliamentary CND.



Carol Turner is Co-Chair chair of London Region CND, a member of CND's International Advisory Group, and of Stop the War Coalition's National Officer Group. Carol is a long-time peace campaigner, a former foreign policy advisor to British parliamentarians, and author of *Corbyn and Trident: Labour's Continuing Controversy*.



Daniel Blaney is Vice Chair of CND and a Labour CND activist. He is a former Councillor in the London Borough of Newham.



Emma Dent-Coad is a Councillor in the London Borough of Kensington and Chelsea and a Vice President of London Region CND. She won the parliament seat for Labour and served as MP for Kensington, 2017-19 and was a Vice Chair of Parliamentary CND. Emma is perhaps best known for her outspoken criticism of the Council and the government over the Grenfell Town disaster.



Hugh Goodacre is a lecturer at University College and Westminster Universities, as well as an amateur musician who regularly performs at trade union events.



Jeremy Corbyn MP is MP for Islington North, and leader of the Labour party 2015-2019. He is the founder of the Peace and Justice Project, an international network which campaigns for social and economic justice, peace, and human rights in Britain and across the world. Jeremy has a long association with the Campaign for Nuclear Disarmament is a Vice President of CND.



Julie Saumagne is London CND's Coordinator. She developed strong campaigning skills as a staff member at The World Transformed and the United Liberation Movement for West Papua. A creative at heart, she also produced designs, websites and brand identities for more than 22 campaigns.



Junayd Islam is Chair of Cambridge Student CND and a leading campaign against US nukes returning to Lakenheath, and a climate change activist.



Karina Lester is a Yankunytjatjara Anangu woman from the Anangu Pitjantjatjara Yankunytjatjara Lands (APY Lands) in South Australia. She is Senior Language Worker at the University of Adelaide, Australia, and an anti-nuclear activist, whose family members suffered as a result of British Nuclear Tests in the 1950s-60s. Karina is an ICAN Ambassador who has participated in the negotiating conference for the UN Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons.



Margaret Kimberley is a leading member of Black Alliance for Peace USA and the United National Antiwar Coalition, USA. She is a co-founder and Executive Editor of Black Agenda Report, and author of *Prejudential: Black America and the Presidents*. Margaret contributes to and broadcasts on a number of platforms including Counterpunch, Common Dreams, Al Jazeera English, and Sky News.



Murad Qureshi is a CND National Councillor. A former London Assembly Member, Murad is also a member of Stop the War Steering Committee and one of the Coalition's former chairs.



Vijay Prashad is an Indian historian, commentator and writer. He is a senior non-resident fellow at Chongyang Institute for Financial Studies, Renmin University of China, and Director of Tricontinental Institute for Social Research, an institute with an emancipatory perspective which seeks to bridge academia and social and political movements.
